**POLICY:**

Members of the Citrus County Board of County Commissioners shall serve on boards or committees in which Federal Laws, Florida Statutes, Florida Administrative Code, or County Ordinances require a commissioner to become a member on those boards that have regional impact or those Boards deemed of importance to the County.

It shall be the policy of the Board for Commissioners that a Commissioner who serves as a member of the Board of Directors or an Officer of any Civic Association, Homeowners Association, or other not-for-profit organization, which receives funding from or is regulated by the Board of County Commissioners shall disclose that service prior to any vote related to funding assistance.

This policy is being instituted to provide transparency of Commissioner service within private sector Boards when Board of County Commissioners vote on any issue to come before them.

Commissioners shall serve as a member on the following boards and committees:

- Citrus, Levy, Marion Regional Workforce Development Consortium
- Public Safety Coordinating Council (Florida Statute 951.26)
- County Juvenile Justice Council (F.S. 39.25, 10-1-94)
- Tourist Development Council (Citrus County Board of County Commissioners Resolution 86-133)
- Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board (Florida Statute Chapter 427, Rule 41-2)
- Withlacoochee Regional Water Supply Authority (Florida Statute requirement, regional impact)
- Withlacoochee Regional Planning Council (Florida Statute requirement, regional impact)
- Tampa Bay Area Regional Transportation Authority
- Chairs Coordinating Committee
- Keep Citrus Beautiful, Inc.
- Value Adjustment Board
- Economic Development Council
- Early Learning Coalition

These are examples, subject to change and should not be considered all-inclusive.

**PROCEDURE:**

- A. The Chairman of the Citrus County Board of County Commissioners shall appoint commissioners to represent the Board on the aforementioned boards and committees.
- B. Should a commissioner desire to serve on a board, committee or task force other than those described above, he/she must either be appointed by the Chairman of the Board or request consideration of the Board of County Commissioners.
