<p><b>Painting / Homeowner Supplies</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Latex Paint (only if still liquid)</li> <li>• Solvent or oil-based paint &amp; stains</li> <li>• Adhesives, epoxies and glues</li> <li>• Aerosol paints and foams</li> <li>• Roofing tars or elastomerics</li> <li>• Paint thinners and turpentine</li> <li>• Paint strippers and removers</li> <li>• Photographic Fixers / Developers</li> </ul>	<p><b>Automotive Products</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fuel and oil additives</li> <li>• Gasoline / Diesel fuel</li> <li>• Starting fluids, aerosols</li> <li>• Transmission and brake fluid</li> <li>• Driveway or concrete paint / sealer</li> <li>• Car wash, tire cleaners</li> <li>• Degreaser, parts cleaner</li> <li>• Windshield washing fluid</li> </ul>

**The following can be recycled six days per week at the Landfill:**

- ✓ **Motor Oil, Oil Filters**
- ✓ **Anti-Freeze, automotive or RV**
- ✓ **Batteries: Lead acid, button or rechargeable**
- ✓ **Fluorescent bulbs and compact fluorescent (CFL) bulbs**
- ✓ **Mercury Switch, Thermostat, or Thermometer (@ scale house)**
- ✓ **Electronic Devices, Circuit Boards, Scrap metal**
- ✓ **Propane Tanks, Extinguishers, Refrigerators, A/C units**
- ✓ **Printer ink cartridges and toner cartridges**
