Guidelines for Transporting and Disposal of Storm Related Debris



After The Storm...

In the event you need to transport and dispose of storm related debris, remember:

After a major storm event, the County may designate a separate vegetative debris disposal location. Check the local media for location and hours. Transport vegetative debris only to the separate location. Other waste will not be accepted. Check for updates and time limits.

If a storm produces significant amounts of structural damage, debris from buildings will also be diverted to a separate staging and disposal area.

When loading materials for disposal at the Central Landfill, please arrange so you can offload into separate areas for the following:

- **Household Garbage & Trash**
- **Furniture, Carpet & Padding**
- **Scrap Metal / Aluminum**
- **Appliances**
- **Waste Tires**
- **Vegetative debris**

Refrigerators or freezers must have doors removed prior to transport to Landfill for disposal.

Always cover your materials during transport to reduce litter on the roadways.

Under emergency situations Solid Waste Management may make appointments for homeowners to dispose of household hazardous waste.
